HOLY LAND COLLECTION

SEPTEMBER 26-27

This year, due to the pandemic caused by the Corona virus, it was not possible to take up the **Good Friday Collection** dedicated to supporting Christians living in the Land of Jesus. Pope Francis has accepted the request to move this 'gesture of sharing' (that concerns the whole church), to September – for us we are taking it up next weekend. September 13 was the Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross, which is celebrated with solemnity, in Jerusalem. It reminds us that the Cross still characterizes and accompanies the journey of the small Christian community that lives in the Holy Land and throughout the Middle East, in the midst of situations of conflict and indifference. This small community suffers even more this year because of the global pandemic. The Collection in favor of the Holy Land is a small gesture of solidarity that the whole Church is called to participate. Thanks to the generosity of Christians throughout the whole world, we will be able to continue taking care of the Holy Places of Christianity; from the Holy Sepulcher to the Basilica of the Nativity; as well as lesser known communities. Your assistance will support the pastoral action to help families, students, refugees, and many others in this region.

40 DAYS FOR LIFE CAMPAIGN

Bismarck, ND– Former Planned Parenthood manager and current 40 Days for Life Director of Outreach Sue Thayer will share her story of transformation in Bismarck on **October 1, 2020**. Thayer will speak at the Bismarck Fall **"40 Days for Life Campaign", which is set for 12:00 Noon at the North Dakota State Capitol**. Bismarck is one of 800+ communities around the world conducting simultaneous 40 Days for Life campaigns from September 23 through November 1. This peaceful, prayerful vigil will run from 8:00 AM to 8:00 PM throughout the full 40 days. 40 Days for Life is an intensive campaign that focuses on 40 days of prayer and fasting for an end to abortion, peaceful vigil at abortion facilities, and grassroots educational outreach. Since 40 Days for Life began, over 17,000 mothers have chosen life for their children; more than 200 abortion workers have quit their jobs; and over 100 abortion centers where 40 Days for Life vigils have been held have gone out of business.
