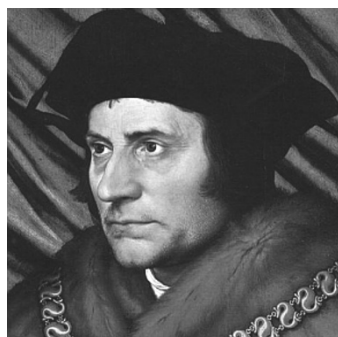

Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Today's readings teach that true Christian discipleship carries significant ethical demands that may be counter-cultural and require considerable spiritual maturity and trust that challenge the worldly wisdom of our age. The first reading is taken from one of Israel's wisdom books, written two hundred years before the birth of Christ, teaches us that "if you trust in God, you too shall live."

In the second reading from Paul's First Letter to the Corinthians, Paul encourages the Corinthian Christians to embrace the mystery of God's wisdom hidden in the crucifixion of Jesus. For Paul, the source of this spiritual maturity and wisdom was the Holy Spirit, and it was a divine gift.

In the Gospel reading for today, we continue to hear from Jesus' Sermon on the Mount. Jesus presented a startling message to his Jewish disciples: "Do not think that I have come to abolish the law or the prophets. I have come not to abolish but to fulfill." For many Jews, the law and the prophets were the embodiment of their sacred Scriptures. Jesus' assertion that he came to fulfill the Jewish Scriptures was an unprecedented claim in Jewish tradition. In the Gospel readings for today and next Sunday we hear six examples of Jesus' expectations for his disciples that go beyond the requirements of the Mosaic Law.

Parish Counseling Network

Struggling with marital issues, parenting, elder care, job loss or bereavement? Take advantage of Catholic Charities affordable – yes; practically free - Parish Counseling Network, which provides parishioners with short-term professional counseling at convenient locations throughout the Archdiocese of New York. Parishioners, referred by the Pastor, are eligible for up to 6 counseling sessions. Fee per session is just a \$10 co-pay.

If additional counseling is needed, parishioners will be referred to counseling practitioners or treatment centers outside the Network. Many practitioners are bilingual in Spanish and English. People needing other services can be referred to one of Catholic Charities regional locations for emergency food, housing, immigration services, addiction services and more.
