- When submitting by email please place your surname and "Photo Contest" in the subject line. (ie: Smith_Photo Contest)
- Please label each digital image with surname and number (ie: Smith_1of2.jpg, Smith_2of2.jpg)



- The photo must be of a New Orleans Catholic Cemetery-photos taken inside the cemetery must be during regular cemetery hours.
- Those eligible sites are St. Patrick, St. Louis, St. Roch, St. Joseph and St. Vincent (Soniata St.) cemeteries in New Orleans; and St. Charles Cemetery in Luling.
- Entries must include the date and location in which the photo was taken.
- Photos may not be submitted with any logo, identifying mark or name on the facing.

- Photos that include people in them will not be considered.
- The photo must be original to the person submitting it.
- Employees of New Orleans Catholic Cemeteries and their families are not eligible for the contest.
- Please do not intrude on a funeral or on the privacy of individuals and families visiting the cemetery.
