



Information About BFSA@Home

Blessed Francis Seelos Academy will be offering our families a choice to attend classes 100% virtually for the 2020-2021 school year.

General Information

- All students will be provided with a school email address to utilize the Google Suite of Apps and Programs
- Students will log in to the regularly scheduled classes through the Google Meet Platform and will be able to watch instruction live, ask questions, and get assistance from the teacher similar to being physically present in the classroom and they will have the ability to interact with classmates as deemed appropriate by the teacher.
- Students will use a blend of synchronous and asynchronous instruction utilizing Google Classroom when streaming is not applicable (for example outside physical education classes)
- Students may be asked to submit assignments through Google Classroom, email, or drop off to school (projects) for grading.
- Students will be expected to submit assignments on time as directed by the teacher.
- Students are expected to log into the classroom on time, follow proper classroom etiquette (not talking during instruction, asking questions when appropriate, etc...)
- Students must be fully dressed in school appropriate attire and need to be seated at a desk or table when in a virtual classroom. Students should not be eating or have television or other distractions around them while in class.

Once chosen, the BFSA@Home will be completed through the 9 week grading period. At the end of the 9 weeks, parents may opt to return to in-person classes or remain in the BFSA@Home program.

It is very important that students are committed to this virtual learning environment and take it seriously. The BFSA@Home program is for families that would like to have their children educated in a faith-based, academically enriching environment while addressing their individual family needs and to assist Blessed Francis Seelos Academy in meeting any health needs of students that may arise.

What the BFSA@Home program is **NOT**:

- It is not for students to take time off of school for unnecessary reasons (trips, desire to sleep in, incomplete work, etc...)
